Hawthorn Leadership School for Girls, the first all-qirls public charter school in Missouri, opened in 2015 with 6th and 7th grade, adding a new grade each year until becoming a full 6-12 school. We celebrated our first graduating class in 2021!

Hawthorn was founded so that young women in St. Louis would have the opportunity to attend an all-girls school with rigorous academics, co-curricular activities that help them expand their talents, and the chance to build deep and lasting friendships. Perhaps more importantly, sisterhood and connection

are baked into the daily culture. Hawthorn endeavors to educate the whole student, so social -emotional learning is just as important as our rigorous STEM curriculum. Our students are encouraged to express themselves during restorative circles, work through their problems using healthy communication and visit our Student Support Center often.

COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS

Hawthorn has a full-time counselor that supports students with their academic planning, post-secondary access, and supports partnerships between the school, universities, and community-based college prep programs. By graduation 100% of Hawthorn graduates have been employed or enrolled in a 2 or 4-year college program.





CULTURE OF LEARNING & ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Teachers receive support through our sponsor, Washington University as well as targeted instructional support and training. Through consistently implemented curriculum, access to grade level content and targeted interventions, Hawthorn is starting to see promising academic growth in its students. Hawthorn's middle school program was recently recognized by SLU's research center as one of the top schools statewide for moving the needle on student learning. Based on 2022 MAP scores, Hawthorn Middle School made the PriME Top 20 List for Statewide Student Growth for Math and English.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL SUPPORT & FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

Hawthorn firmly believes in supporting the whole student and providing support to nurture both their academic and personal growth to ensure student wellness and positive development. Our small size and tight knit culture provide students with the opportunity to be part of a unique and supportive sisterhood.

Hawthorn has significantly increased family engagement throughout the 2022-2023 school year, hosting core engagement events and adding a Parent Engagement Group.



100% Hawthorn students will complete the ACT, participate in college presentations and visits, and have access to college counseling.



50% (approx) of Hawthorn families use school provided transportation, leading to an increase in attendance month after month.
