



Uniform Policy

Middle School Uniform Expectations

Mandatory Dress Uniform for special events/occasions (and daily, if student chooses):

- Tops: Hawthorn logo polo shirt (white or burgundy) or white button down logo oxford shirt
- Bottoms: Black pants or grey kilt
- Shoes: Closed toe shoes with a back

Daily Uniform (for any school day *except* days designated as “Dress Uniform” by administrators due to special events/occasions):

- Tops: Hawthorn logo polo shirt (white or burgundy) or white button down logo oxford shirt; outerwear purchased through the school’s uniform vendor or the school’s spirit store
- Bottoms: Black pants or grey kilt
- Shoes: Closed toe shoes with a back

No leggings, jeggings nor jeans/denim are permitted. Black pants do not need to be purchased through the school’s uniform vendor. Please refer to the uniform policy in the family handbook for additional uniform information.

High School Uniform Expectations

Mandatory Dress Uniform for special events/occasions (and daily, if student chooses):

- Tops: Hawthorn logo blazer, white logo button down oxford shirt
- Bottoms: black pants, khaki pants, or Hawthorn plaid skirt
- Tops: Hawthorn logo blazer, white logo button down oxford shirt
- Shoes: Closed toe shoes with a back

Daily Uniform (for any school day *except* days designated as “Dress Uniform” by administrators due to special events/occasions):

- Tops: yellow, grey, or white logo polos, white logo button down oxford shirt, outerwear purchased through the school’s uniform vendor or the school’s spirit store
- Bottoms: black pants, khaki pants, or Hawthorn plaid skirt
- Shoes: Closed toe shoes with a back

No leggings, jeggings nor jeans/denim are permitted. Black/khaki pants do not need to be purchased through the uniform vendor. Please refer to the uniform policy in the family handbook for additional uniform information.

All middle/high school students must dress out for PE/Dance. Students must wear closed-toe shoes with a back in PE.

Uniform Violation Consequences

SSO office tracks and monitors uniform infractions by the end of the first class period.

Consequences for uniform violations escalate for repeated infractions including a) phone call home b) 1st Lunch Detention c) 2nd After School Detention d) mandatory parent meeting e) loss of privilege (field trip, incentives etc) f) In School Suspension
